Dear Rockville Resident,

We are thankful to receive comments from many of you. As a follow-up to our earlier notice to you dated April 11, 2008 regarding safety and vehicular circulation improvement in your neighborhood, the City of Rockville has slightly modified its plans, based on some of your comments, to install no parking zones on Autumn Wind Way.

The zones are located on the reverse curves on Autumn Wind Way north of Rose Petal Way intersection. When cars are parked on both sides of Autumn Wind Way, the drive space is narrow and allows only one vehicle to pass at a time. While the narrow roadway provides to the neighborhood the benefit of slowing cars, at peculiar locations it may make it difficult for large vehicles to pass.

We are particularly concerned that large emergency vehicles have difficulty passing through this section of Autumn Wind Way when cars are parked on both sides of the street. To ensure access by large emergency vehicles along the entire roadway at all times, the City will mostly limit street parking to only one side of the street along the reverse curves approaching Rose Petal Way.

The enclosed map reflect two modifications: the addition of three permissible parking spaces on the west side of Autumn Wind Way near its intersection with Rose Petal; and designation of no-parking area north of the access to alley driveway up to the mailbox area. The map shows portions of the road that will be designated as no parking zones, and where the No Parking signs will be placed. The City of Rockville plans to install the no parking signs by the end of June 2008.

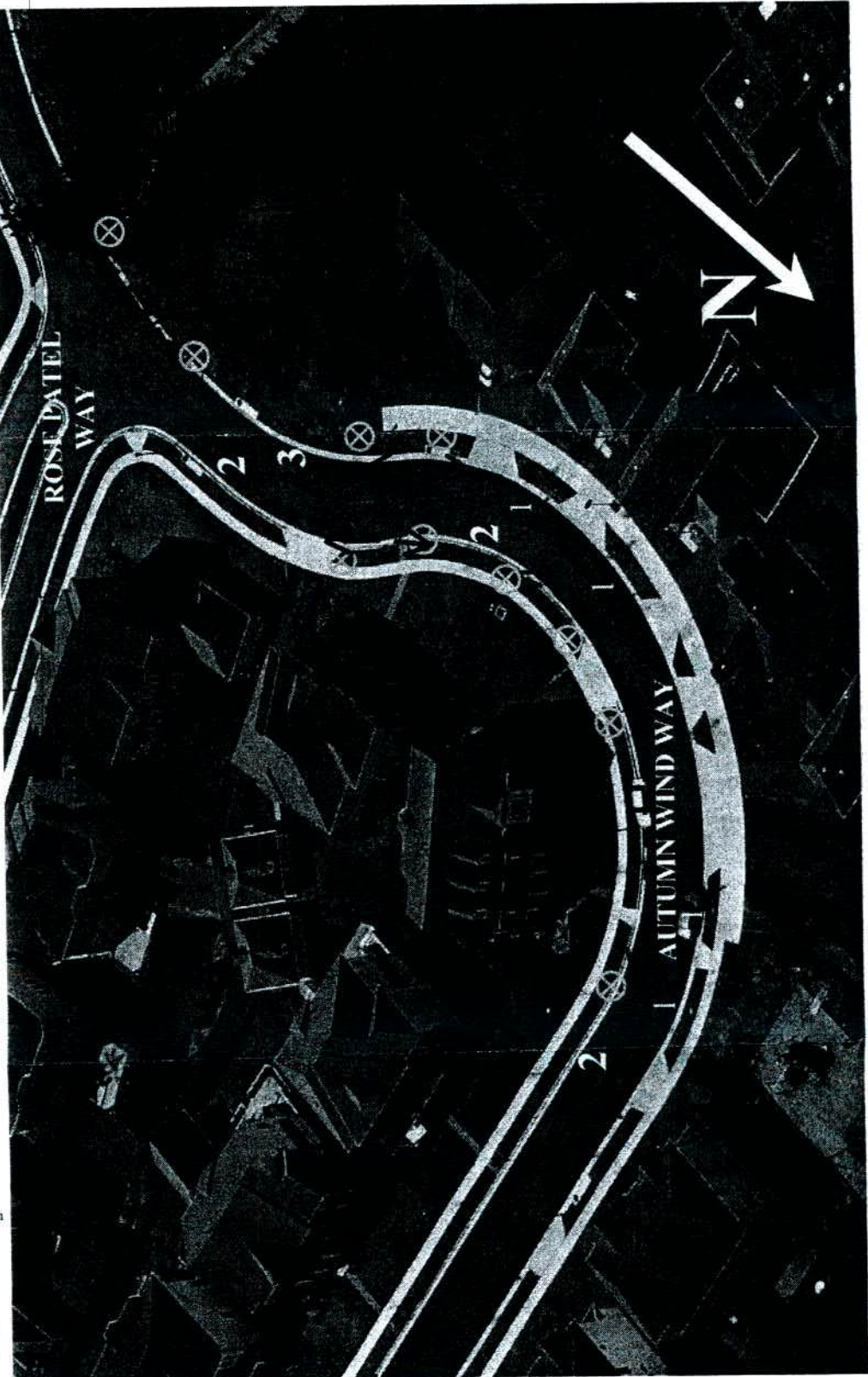
