Topics

1. Brigitta Mullican

Brigitta, having recently renewed her membership, made a broad request for Minutes and financial reports and made broad allegations of nondisclosure and other irregularities, including claims of our not passing a budget and not sending her renewal notices, which we dispute.

2. CIP Proposal Discussion

Marilyn Al-Mansoor, who is President of the East Rockville Civic Association, chatted with us about possible Capital Improvement Program (CIP) projects that the City of Rockville might undertake. Brigitta objected in principle to TCA's forwarding recommendations and suggestions concerning these, claiming that it is undemocratic for TCA to speak out and take a position if Brigitta disagreed. We clarified that the City would be taking similar lists from all sorts of groups, and that TCA was not the decision maker for CIP projects. We also pointed out that Brigitta could send her own inputs as well. We proceeded to discuss a fairly extensive wish list, debating such matters as whether to suggest an expansion of the Twinbrook Community Recreation Center or that a new one be built on the edge of Rockcrest park (Dr. Wilcox's proposal). Christina asked Ms. Mullican to specify which of the 28 CIP requests under discussion she found objectionable; and Ms. Mullican replied that she did not object to any of the CIP requests. After consensus was reached, Christina agreed to prepare and submit the necessary CIP paperwork to the City.

3. Financial Reports

The Secretary notes that Rich has e-mailed the Executive Committee the monthly Financial Reports for June, July, August, September, and October 2009.
