What is Wi-FiTM?

Put simply, Wi-FiTM, or Wireless Fidelity, is freedom. It's independence. It's highspeed Internet access without the constraints of cables or wires. Wi-FiTM allows you to connect to the Internet from your couch at home, a bed in a hotel room, or a conference room at work without the

inconvenience of wires. Wi-Fi[™] technology is similar to that of a cordless phone—a

small base station permits the end-user to roam about a limited distance and remain connected. More importantly, Wi-FiTM, whose official name is Wireless Local Area Network (WLAN), allows several individuals to share one broadband connection at no additional cost and without pulling cumbersome cables.

Sharing Cable/DSL Using Wi-Fi™


The most popular application today shares a single high-speed Internet jack (cable/ DSL) among several home/office computers. With a WLAN, there is no more hog-

ging the Internet by one person. In an apartment or home office, using Wi-Fi™ equipment in your network gives

each individual the ability to surf the Web, play games, stream video, and share files, simultaneously. A Wi-Fi[™] network can easily share cable/DSL connections among 10 to 15 users.
